The Sumter County Sheriff's Office will be hosting its **Annual Youth Conferences:**

The **"Boys To Men Conference"** will be held on Friday and Saturday, June 11th and 12th 2010 at Crestwood High School located at 2000 Oswego Road, Sumter, SC; and

The **"Girls To Women Conference"** will be held on Friday and Saturday, July 23rd and 24th 2010 at Chestnut Oaks Middle School located at 1200 Oswego Road.

The conferences are aimed at building character and leadership skills among boys and girls ages 10 to 17. Topics of discussion include gang violence, sexually transmitted diseases, teenage pregnancy, domestic violence, budgeting and finances, making positive career choices, and we promote education and a deep desire to attend institutions of higher learning.

Registration fee is \$25 per camper. Registration begins at 7am Friday morning with various other activities scheduled throughout the day and evening. The campers will stay overnight and the conferences resume early Saturday morning. Graduation ceremonies are scheduled to begin at 12 noon, and the conferences will end at approximately 2pm Saturday. Parents are encouraged to attend graduation.

Each camper is to bring any medications needed; personal hygiene items to include soap, tooth paste, and deodorant; wash towels, and bed covers. Campers (boys & girls) may wear shorts, but the length should extend to the knees. Otherwise, shorts are prohibited. Females may wear skirts provided they are knee length or below. Cots will be provided, therefore sleeping bags are optional.

Meals & snacks will be provided throughout the conferences as well, to include breakfast on Friday morning.

We are soliciting your support by asking that you sponsor a child or children or simply make a monetary contribution. Volunteers may assist, however criminal background checks of all volunteers will be conducted by the Sumter County Sheriff's Office. It is our mission to make our youth prosperous and productive citizens of the future.
