

ORDINANCE NO. 05-560

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING
THROUGH-TRUCK TRAFFIC ON SOUTH MAIN STREET
BETWEEN THE LIBERTY STREET
AND POCALLA ROAD**

WHEREAS, South Main Street is situate partially within the corporate limits of the City of Sumter and wholly within Sumter County, terminating on the north at Liberty Street and terminating on the south at Pocalla Road, (U. S. Highway 15) ; and

WHEREAS, the part of South Main Street which is outside the corporate limits of the City of Sumter services and is primarily bordered by residential property; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public safety, particularly those people living in residences along South Main Street and serviced by South Main Street and those people who must use South Main Street to travel to their residences to limit the truck traffic on South Main Street; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Ordinance, appropriate signage may be erected indicating “No Thru Trucks” thereby prohibiting any vehicle having ten (10) or more wheels from using South Main Street as a throughway or means of passage to another destination.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF SUMTER, SOUTH CAROLINA, AT ITS REGULAR MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED AND BY THE AUTHORITY THEREOF:

Through traffic is prohibited for vehicles having ten (10) or more wheels on the part of South Sumter Street which is outside the corporate limits for the City of Sumter.
