

(OA--03-30) -- AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MAP SHOWING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE RANGE COMPATIBILITY DISTRICT AND NOISE NOTIFICATION AREA TO BE THE SAME AS THE AIRSPACE BOUNDARIES FOR POINSETT RANGE (R6002) OF ODINANCE NO. 99-371 KNOWN AS THE SUMTER COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the request by the Planning Commission Staff to amend the text of the County Comprehensive Plan Ordinance, has been duly considered by the Planning Commission and all requirements have been complied with as outlined by Statute Statues and local laws; and

WHEREAS, the request has been forwarded to Sumter County Council with a recommendation for approval from the Planning Commission and County Council members concur with the Commission's recommendation;

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained By the County Council Of The County Of Sumter, South Carolina, At Its Regular Meeting Duly Assembled And By The Authority There Of Amend Ordinance #99-371 as follows:

Ordinance Change

Amend the Comprehensive Plan Map showing the boundaries of the Range Compatibility District and Noise Notification Area to be the same as the airspace boundaries for Poinsett Range (R6002) as shown on attached maps.

NOTE: The primary impact of this change will be more building permits and plats stamped with notification of the noise potential and notification to the real estate industry to help them notify customers of the noise potential.

All other sections of the Zoning And Development Standards Ordinance of the County of Sumter, South Carolina, and subsequent amendments, shall remain as previously adopted.
