WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant finding of migration projects; and

WHEREAS, Sumter County Government participated jointly in the planning process with the other units of government in the Santee-Lynches Region to prepare hazard mitigation plan;

WHEREAS, Sumter County Government is aware that revision and updating of the plan is critical for active and effective hazard mitigation and that Sumter County Government will monitor and record hazard related data and events that can be used to update the all natural hazards mitigation plan.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that Sumter County Council, of Sumter County, South Carolina, do hereby accepts and approves the Hazard Mitigation Plan of it designated portion in its entirety as an official plan and will undertake annual recording of hazard events, their impact, duration, and cost.

Be It Further Resolved, that Sumter County Council, accepting the Hazards Risk Assessment and Mitigation Plan from Santee-Lynches Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee, will submit on behalf of the participating counties and municipalities the adopted Hazard Plan to the Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for the final review and approval.
